- 8. Participating in international peacekeeping missions, humanitarian assistance and training.

RECRUITMENT CONDITIONS

For any person to be recruited in Rwanda National Police, must meet the following conditions:

A. BASIC COURSE

- 1. To be Rwandan Nationality;
- 2. Being a volunteer;
- 3. To be at least 18 years old and not more than 25 years old;
- 4. To have a senior six(6) certificate;
- 5. To be with good behavior and morals;
- 6. Not to have had any criminal conviction of more than six months;
- 7. To be holding a diploma or another certificate certifying that he has capacities corresponding to the recruitment level;
- 8. To be healthy and strong enough to work in Police, this being supported by a medical certificate issued by a Doctor registered by the State;
- 9. Not to have been dismissed from his functions without consultation or expelled from any public service without notice;
- 10. To have passed tests for recruitment into the Rwanda National Police;

B. CADET COURSE

- 1. To be Rwandan Nationality;
- 2. Being a volunteer;
- 3. To be at least 18 years old and not more than 35 years old;
- 4. To have at least a University degree;
- 5. To be with good behavior and morals;
- 6. Not to have had any criminal conviction of more than six months;
- 7. To be holding a diploma or another certificate certifying that he has capacities corresponding to the recruitment level;
- 8. To be healthy and strong enough to work in Police, this being supported by a medical certificate issued by a Doctor registered by the State;
- 9. Not to have been dismissed from his functions without consultation or expelled from any public service without notice;
- 10. To have passed tests for recruitment into the Rwanda National Police;
